GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS


1. The Candidates are being called for the Written Test on the basis of the details furnished in the online application. In case any candidate fails to substantiate the particulars furnished in the online application (viz. date of birth, reservation category, percentage of marks/CGPA with respect to prescribed educational qualification etc.) or concealed/distorted any information or found to be not meeting the prescribed qualifications at any stage of the recruitment, his/her candidature will be deemed invalid.
2. Candidates should duly affix a recent passport size photograph in the area provided in the Admit Card. **However, the signature shall be made by the candidate only in the presence of the Invigilator in the Written Test Hall. The candidate will not be allowed to attend the Written Test without the Admit Card.**
3. The Candidates are also advised to carry a valid photo ID card viz. Aadhaar/PAN card/Driving License/Electoral ID etc. alongwith the Admit Card.
4. **Those candidates coming without recent photo affixed Admit Card and/or valid ID card will not be allowed to write the Written Test.**
5. The Written Test will be from **1000 hrs to 1130 hrs (1½ Hrs duration)**. However the candidates should report at the venue one hour before commencement of the Written Test, i.e.; at **0900 Hrs**. Candidates would not be admitted to the Written Test venue after half-an-hour of the commencement of the Written Test, i.e.; **1030 Hrs**.
6. Candidates would not be permitted to leave the Written Test hall until completion of the Written Test, i.e.; **1130 Hrs**. No candidate shall leave the Written Test Hall without prior permission of the Invigilator. Candidates must abide by the instructions of the Invigilator.
7. Candidates alone will be permitted inside the Written Test venue.
8. Candidates are not permitted to use Electronic gadgets viz. Calculators, Mobile Phones, Bluetooth/Wired Headsets, Smart Watches, Pendrives/Storage Devices, CD/DVDs, Cameras, Tablets, PCs, Laptops etc. or any other Reference Books/Materials inside the Written Test Hall. Candidates found using or attempt to use any unfair means shall be summarily disqualified.

10. The Written Test will be of 60 objective type questions and each question carries 03 marks for correct answer. **One negative mark will be deducted for each wrong answer. Multiple answers for a question will be treated as wrong answer.**
 11. Four options are provided against each question, of which only one will be the right answer. The candidate has to indicate his/her option legibly in the OMR Answer sheet.
 12. Candidates should carefully go through the instructions in the Question Booklet before answering.
 13. Use **BALL POINT PEN OF BLUE/BLACK INK** for marking answers in the OMR Answer Sheet. Rough work, if any, shall be done on the area provided in the Question Booklet.
 14. On completion of the Written Test, tear the OMR Answer Sheet at the perforation mark at the top and hand over the original OMR Answer Sheet to the invigilator and retain the duplicate copy. **Utmost care should be taken while separating the original OMR Answer Sheet from the duplicate copy that, any damage made to the original sheet while tearing will automatically invalidate the OMR Answer Sheet.**
 15. The Candidates should handover Admit Card & OMR Answer Sheet to the Invigilator, before leaving the Written Test Hall. The Question Booklet and duplicate copy of the OMR Answer Sheet shall be retained by the candidate.
 16. No Travelling Allowance will be paid to the candidates attending the Written Test.
 17. The Time, Date and Venue of the Examination shall not be changed for any reasons.
 18. Any canvassing by or on behalf of the candidates or to bring political or other outside influence with regard to the selection/recruitment shall be considered as DISQUALIFICATION.
